Sleeping Arrangements:

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Driving Directions

From I-15:

Take Exit 78 in Cedar City and follow the signs to Cedar Breaks. As you leave town and start up the canyon you will travel 7-10 miles and the Center will be on your right-hand side (going up the canyon).
