Team Provides: Clipboard, non-programmable calculator, and a pencil. Also please bring with you any Egg Candling Units you have, the more we have the better.

All team members will be required to wear a mask, covering their nose and mouth, during the duration of CDEs.

Participants will be using scantrons for this event. A sample copy of the scantron is available on the Utah FFA website. Please familiarize your competitors with the scantron prior to the event. Errors made by contestants in completing the scantron WILL NOT result in their scores being changed or fixed.

Contest Details

The Poultry CDE will be held in the Recreation building. We will be using www.judgingcard.com to score the event.

The event will follow the 2016-2021 National FFA Poultry Evaluation CDE rules with the following exceptions:

1. Class 1 (Broiler Placing Class) will be included and participants will be asked to give oral reasons on their placing of this class.
2. There will be no Class 2 (Laying Hens Placing Class) to place.
3. There will be no Class 14 (Team Activity)

Teams

- Teams will consist of up to 4 members. Team ranking is determined by combining the score of all team members.
- It is highly recommended that participants wear FFA Official Dress.
- Each team will report to the Recreation Building at the scheduled time and place. No participant, advisor, or coach may enter the event area before the specified time.
- Each team will receive a computer scan sheet. Please familiarize your competitors with the scantron form prior to the event.
- A sample copy of the scantron form that will be used is available at www.utahffa.org under career development event resources.
- Errors made by contestants in completing the form WILL NOT result in their scores being changed or fixed.

Participants

- Participants will have eight [8] minutes per class to complete the Classes.
- Participants will have twenty-four [24] minutes to complete the Exam.
- Any participant in possession of any electronic device not required by event rules is subject to disqualification (phones, earbuds, etc.)
- Talking, switching assigned groups, and/or not following instructions, will result in one [1] warning. If a participant is found to be violating these rules for a second time, they will be disqualified.

Humane Treatment of Live Animals

- All live animals must be treated with the utmost care and respect.
- Violation of this rule will automatically disqualify the offending team member.
- The supervision, interpretation, and enforcement of this rule will be the responsibility of the event host and/or his/her designee.
